



Winter Art Techlympics 2018 - Team Information

How the Art Techlympics work:

10 teams compete against each other in events outlined below. Teams are made up of 5 people, each member of a team must compete in at least one of the individual events and all together in the team events.

Points are awarded to each team for each event in the following ways which is outlined for each event:

- Timed event - your time will give you a placing out of 10 teams, eg. fastest time receives 10 points, slowest time gets 1 point.
- Completion event – your team gets ONE point
- Clap-o-meter – the team the audience claps the loudest for receives 10 points, quietest receives 1 point.

The first 5 events your team can compete in, then there is one semi- final event. The 3 teams who have the highest scores after the semi final event will compete for Bronze, Silver & Gold in the final event.

Uniform:

You can wear whatever you like as long as there is some sort of winter theme to your Team Uniform or every team member is wearing something consistent across all your team - as well as steel capped boots! Don't go too extravagant as you want to be able to move around freely whilst you are getting physical.

Before the event:

- Organise a team of 5 people,
- Fill in the registration form on the website <https://www.arttechlympics.uk/thegames>
- Pay for your team <https://www.arttechlympics.uk/tickets>
- Read and sign the liability waiver - email it to us at contact@arttechspace.com or bring it on the day,
- Read the rules and make sure you know what you can and can't do – you don't want to be penalised for anything!
- Read the events descriptions and assign a team member to each event (there isn't time on the day to work this out sorry),
- Assemble your tool kit to bring on the day so you are all ready to go straight away at 2pm.

On the day:

- Arrive before 1:45pm to complete registration (venue opens at 1pm),
- All your team needs to be ready to start in their uniforms at 1:45 for the start of the events at 2pm. If a team mate is not present at 1:45pm then they cannot compete – no if's or but's.
- Have all your tool kit ready to go by 1:45pm,
- Get yourself an area for your team to hang out and to keep your tools,
- Timings of events are just a guide, we will try to work to them, but who is to say what will happen on the day,
- Get ready to have a truck load of FUN!!!!
